## **Cancellation/Refund Policy and Payments**

The deadline for a refund on a cancellation is 14 days prior to the date the competition commences. After the deadline, refunds will only be considered in cases of emergency when accompanied by a Doctor's Certificate, and may be subject to a \$100 service fee. Cancellations taken at the event cannot be substituted by another entry, and no refund will be made on such cancellations. Package cancellations received by July 10th will receive a full refund. Cancellation received between July 10th and July 25th will be charged a \$250 package cancellation fee for non-recoverable processing costs. Payments made after the Deadline, June 26th must be in the form of Cashiers Checks, Money Order, or Cash.

#### **General Rules**

All persons attending this event, whether as a spectator, competitor, official, studio employee or guest of the organizer, shall be bound by the N.D.C.A. rules, and by participating in this event, automatically become obliged to adhere to them. The International Grand Ball Championships and participating studios accept no responsibilities for any loss or theft of articles left in changing rooms, ballroom, or hotel rooms or for any loss and/or injury sustained by persons attending this event. Everyone does so at his/her own risk.

Because of N.D.C.A. rules, no videotaping or filming will be allowed. However, a professional video production company will be on hand to video your dancing. Tapes will be made available for purchase.

The International Grand Ball Championships will not be liable for any personal charges made at the hotel. All participants must pay their own personal charges, including phone charges, room service, etc.

There will be no smoking allowed in the ballroom or changing rooms. All competing Professionals and Amateurs must be currently registered with the N.D.C.A. or equivalent association/organization, and proof of current registration must be shown when registering. # **Scholarship & Other Competitions**

To qualify for any scholarship event, a student must have a minimum of 5 other entries per scholarship entered. Multi-dance events count as 2 other entries. In the event of lack of entries – the organizer has the right to cancel or to reduce the prize money for any Pro/Am, Amateur scholarships, Professional Championship events!!!

### World Pro/Am DSS

There are three age groups: A (16 – 35), B (36 – 50), and C (51 – over) in each of the four styles. All divisions are unisex and levels are Bronze, Silver and Open Gold. You have to enter the same age in all events throughout the year. The student can only represent one age and one style in November 2019. The teacher can be represented more than once. Points will be based on accumulation of callbacks and placements earned throughout the 2019 series events starting with the 2018 Ohio Star Ball. #### **Solo Routines**

No Solo Routine is to exceed three minutes. Music will be faded out after 3 minutes. All solo routine music must be on CD or IPOD. Please make recordings carefully and use the best available equipment.

Newcomer: Evening wear is suggested (Cocktail dresses for the ladies and jackets or vests for the Gentleman) For Solo Routines, costumes are acceptable.

Pre-Teen and Junior competitors: Please be aware of the current N.D.C.A. Rules.

All other competitors may wear costumes for all levels.
